

Pursuant to the PSC Staff's current review of the SBC program, I submit the following comment on behalf of DayStar Technologies, Inc. ("DayStar")

DayStar is located at Halfmoon, in Saratoga County, New York and engaged in the manufacture of highly efficient, flexible and lightweight solar cells. We heartily endorse the use of the SBC to encourage the development and commercialization of renewable energy sources.

DayStar, formerly of California, moved to New York in 2004, based in large part on the progressive attitude of State agencies, especially NYSERDA, toward the promotion of commercial solar cells. We encourage the expansion of the SBC program to fulfill this purpose.
