■ request that the funding for the SBC III to be used for residential programs. ■ believe we should not cut these programs for residential clients; it is an important benefit to those who use programs through NYSERDA.

Also ■ request that the following be considered:

- the time frame be extended beyond 5 years, perhaps up to 10 years to allow the programs to mature
- Increase the funding for the residential side, perhaps a 50/50 split between residential and commercial
- Increase the funding for the low income programs to perhaps 15%
- Include a program for residential Natural Gas customers  
Increase the funding above the 150 million level
