
I am writing to request that the funding of SBC III be used to support residential energy conservation programs. It is important for the residential clients to have the Public Service Commission not cut these programs, programs like the Assisted Home Performance Program, Empower NY, etc.

I would also request that the following comments be considered:

- the time frame be extended beyond 5 years, perhaps up to 10 years to allow the programs to mature
- Increase the funding for the residential side, perhaps a **50/50** split between residential and commercial  
Increase the funding for the low income programs to perhaps 15%
- Include a program for residential Natural Gas customers
- Increase the funding above the 150 million level
