Dear Secretary Brillig:

Taylor Recycling Facility (TRF) a processor of construction and demolition material, headquartered in Montgomery New York, submits the following comments for the Commission's Notice Regarding Service of Comments, dated October 13, 2005.

Taylor Recycling Facility an innovator in the area of recycling process improvement has benefited through NYSERDA's involvement in the development of an efficient approach to the use of solid discarded materials. Taylor supports the continuation of the SBC for a term and level of funding as suggested by Commission Staff. In addition Taylor offers the following comments for your consideration:

1) While the benefits from the SBC supported programs accrue in large part to all New York State residents not all are included in the funding. The SBC should be applied universally to all parties provided electric service in the State.

2) An assessment should be made of the administrative costs involved in program delivery and these costs compared against other programs both public and private.

3) Especially as it relates to the RPS, steps need to be taken to promote the competitive market place.

4) Utilities should be provided access to some percentage of SBC generated funds to allow for franchise targeted programs that are geared specifically to franchise area customers.

5) Preference should be given to state-headquartered companies or service providers hired by NYSERDA or the PSC to investigate or deliver SBC supported programs.

These comments and general support for SBC continuation are submitted for your review and consideration.
