Here is the final information regarding the Overview Forum on July 19-20, 2007 at Albany Law School.

First, I am happy to inform you that the entire program will be broadcast live on the Internet. The Internet broadcast can be viewed by accessing New York Admin at <http://www.NewYorkAdmin.com/cgi-bin/nypsc.cgi> from a computer capable of using RealPlayer. RealPlayer can be downloaded from the NewYorkAdmin web site. The Commission has no financial interest in the Web site, its management, maintenance or administration.

There are 30 free slots available at one time. If the 31st person tries to view the forum through this NYAdmin web site, the person will receive a note to try at a later time.

Second, Powerpoint will be available at the forum. All speakers and panelists who intend to use Powerpoint should forward their presentations to John D'Aloia, at [john\\_daloia@dps.state.ny.us](mailto:john_daloia@dps.state.ny.us) no later than noon tomorrow, July 18, 2007, and should also bring a copy of their presentations in a medium that can be uploaded. A laptop will be provided, with the presentations already in place, for your convenience and to save time. With the permission of the speakers, all Powerpoint presentations provided for the Overview Forum will be available on the web page for this proceeding.

Speakers and panelists are instructed not to bring paper copies of their presentations for distribution. In line with the low-carbon profile of this proceeding, no paper copies of Powerpoint presentations will be distributed.

Third, participants will receive final instructions at the event, but lunch will be available for purchase at the University Heights campus center behind the Law School. Parking permits will be distributed to participants at the kiosk at the entrance to the Albany Law School parking lot, on Holland Avenue just off New Scotland Avenue.
