Working Group I: EPS Administration

Criteria for Administrative Model Selection

- Which entity or entities bear responsibility for meeting the EPS goals and does/should administration attach to the responsible entity?
- Does the model take advantage of the inherent strengths of the various participants and present a coherent structure for coordination and cooperation?
- Does the model minimize functional overlap and duplication of effort?
- Does the model build on the existing program development and delivery infrastructure or will it require deployment of additional financial and human resources?
- Is the model comprehensive enough to limit balkanization of program effort, while remaining flexible enough to accommodate differing conditions (e.g., geographic, climatic, load, institutional) across the state?
- Does the entity(ies) responsible for program administration have a clear corporate mission to secure cost-effective energy efficiency? Is there interest by the named in serving in this capacity?
- Is the model structured to allow meaningful and timely oversight, feedback and reallocation of effort and resources?
