

Your total electricity price is made up of **delivery**, **supply** and **transition** charges. The **delivery** charge is what you pay NYSEG to transport electricity to you over our power lines. The **supply** charge is what you pay for the electricity purchased on your behalf by NYSEG or an ESCO.

The **transition** charge reflects the costs of making the electricity industry more competitive and includes associated credits and/or charges. This charge will be part of your bill whether you receive electricity supply from NYSEG or an ESCO.

On average, a residential customer's electricity costs can be broken down as follows:



Your choice primarily affects the **supply** portion of your bill. **The delivery charge is the same for each choice except for customers taking service from an ESCO on the Competitive Supplier Price Choice (described later in this kit) which has a 0.4-cent credit applied to the delivery charge monthly.**

NYSEG Delivers for You



NYSEG is an energy delivery company. Whether you purchase your electricity supply from NYSEG or an ESCO, NYSEG will continue to safely and reliably deliver your electricity. If your power is interrupted or you have questions regarding your delivery service, NYSEG will be there for you.

Your Supply Choices

Each choice consists of a **supply** charge and a **transition** charge. These charges are either fixed – the same amount – or variable – changing monthly. **The delivery charges under all of the supply choices will be fixed for the two-year period.** Read on for a description of each electricity supply choice.

■ Competitive Supplier Price Choice

This choice consists of an ESCO supply charge (which depends on the offer you accept from the ESCO you choose) and a *variable* NYSEG transition charge.

■ NYSEG Fixed Price Choice

This choice consists of a *fixed* NYSEG supply charge and a *fixed* NYSEG transition charge. The fixed supply charge includes the cost of electricity plus the cost of procuring electricity and for managing the risk of providing a fixed price over the two-year period.

■ NYSEG Fixed Price Choice with Supply Credit

This choice is made up of an ESCO supply charge (which depends on the offer you accept from the ESCO you choose), *fixed* NYSEG supply and transition charges plus a *variable* NYSEG supply credit (a credit on your NYSEG charges because you purchase your supply from an ESCO). The amount of the credit is based on the market price of electricity each month.

■ NYSEG Variable Price Choice

This choice consists of a *variable* NYSEG supply charge and a *variable* NYSEG transition charge. The variable supply and transition charges reflect the changing market cost of electricity each month.

Electricity Price Comparisons

Be sure to calculate all your charges (delivery, supply and transition charges and supply credit if applicable) to determine your total electricity cost. 


