NOTICE OF INTERVENTION AND COMMENTS OF
THE NEW YORK STATE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

BACKGROUND

On May 27, 2010, TC Ravenswood, LLC (Ravenswood) filed a complaint with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) against the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO), seeking reimbursement of variable costs incurred in complying with "Minimum Oil Burn" rules (Complaint). On May 28, 2010, the Commission issued a "Notice of Complaint," establishing a June 16, 2010 deadline for comments on Ravenswood's Complaint.

On June 3, 2010, the NYISO filed a "Motion to Modify the Deadline for Answers and Comments" (NYISO Motion), seeking to establish a deadline of June 28, 2010, for answers and comments to Ravenswood's Complaint. On June 4, 2010, the Commission issued a "Notice Shortening Date for Filing Answers

to Motion" (June 4 Notice) and established a June 7, 2010 deadline for submitting comments on NYISO's Motion.

NOTICE OF INTERVENTION AND COMMENTS

The New York State Public Service Commission (NYPSC) hereby submits its Notice of Intervention and Comments in support of the NYISO's Motion, pursuant to Rules 212 and 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 CFR §§ 385.212 and 385.214), and the Commission's June 4 Notice.
