

Paul Belnick, Director-Energy Services Division, New York Power Authority

Paul began his utility career in 1986 at the Long Island Lighting Company as Division Manager of Load Research. In addition to traditional load and class studies this group was also responsible for planning and evaluating demand side management programs.

In 1992, Paul joined the New York Power Authority, and began implementing energy efficiency programs in State owned facilities across the State. The target market for this program was expanded to public schools and county and local governments through the 1990's. Today, these programs are offered to all publicly operated facilities statewide and in 2006, \$120M in projects were implemented. In addition, measures were added to the programs to include all - encompassing energy saving measures both electric and non-electric.

In 2003, Paul was promoted to Director of Energy Services Programs and is currently responsible for all energy services programs offered by the New York Power Authority.

Paul has a BS degree in Industrial Engineering from SUNY Buffalo and an MBA from Indiana University.
