

CHANGES IN YOUR BILL 2014

This information is provided by the New York State Department of Public Service for customers of PSEG-LI.

On April 1, 2014, PSEG-LI implemented several changes which affect certain line items on your electricity bill. Department of Public Service experts reviewed the proposed changes and found that consistent with the LIPA Reform Act goals, these changes address two important objectives: 1) To maintain stability in the non-fuel portion of the customer's bill for 2014 and 2015 and 2) To invest in the Long Island electric system to significantly improve customer satisfaction and storm response for PSEG-LI customers. Overall, the bill changes are minimal and offer significant immediate and long term benefits to Long Island electric customers.

Bill Comparison Facts

The bill comparison reflects a 30-day bill cycle for a residential customer that uses 715 KWH per month, which is the average monthly use for PSEG-LI customers during the winter. This particular scenario demonstrates a slight decrease in the customer's bill. In fact, most customers will see no changes or a slight decrease, while others may see a small increase of 0.07% annually. The minor shifts, shown in red text, are in the non-fuel portion of the bill and have little to no impact on the total charges.

Key Benefits

The tariff changes are a result of the LIPA Reform Act, which reduces state assessments and other taxes for LIPA, enabling PSEG-LI to:

- Avoid filing for a rate increase in 2014 and 2015
- Invest in transmission and delivery infrastructure
- Invest in storm response technology to match best-in-class systems
- Invest in call center technology to significantly improve our customers' experience
- Implement best-practice customer satisfaction processes for enhanced quality and responsiveness
